

Dear Velma Anne Ruth,

Thank you for sharing the ICBM EAR Report – Week of December 15, prepared by Peter Huessy.

I am a member of Cyrus Force, working in coordination with Stand Up America, a U.S.-based foundation. The subject of your report may also be of interest to our mentor, General Paul E. Vallely (USA, Ret.), whom I will copy on this message.

There is one sentence in the report that compels me to respond directly:

“...state-sponsored terrorism, and such state and non-state actors as North Korea, China, Iran, Venezuela and Hezbollah, Hamas and Al Qaeda.”

I will be frank and put this in writing. After more than thirty years of engaging American policymakers, and after writing several books on Iran, religion, and political Islam, I can say this plainly: with the sole exception of the late Henry Kissinger, I have not heard a single coherent or informed assessment of Iran from any past or present U.S. National Security Advisor.

The repeated, recycled narrative about the Ayatollahs’ “terrorism” is not only intellectually lazy—it is dangerously inadequate.

If past or current National Security Advisors were required to pass even an entry-level examination on Iran—its clerical system, Shi’a political theology, or the Constitution of the Islamic Republic written 46 years ago—they would fail. The reason is simple: they have not read it, and they do not understand it.

I will also state a belief formed through decades of study: the Islamic Republic is not an organic Iranian phenomenon. It is a regime shaped through British strategic engineering, and in many ways represents London’s long-term geopolitical revenge after the United States displaced British dominance in Iran and the Middle East. Among Iranians, this is often expressed bluntly: under the turban of every Ayatollah is written “Made in England.” While phrased colloquially, the historical argument behind it deserves serious examination, not dismissal.

At Cyrus Force, we have largely stopped writing to politicians. However, when a respected individual such as yourself, or a distinguished institution, circulates a

serious report, I respond with a single paragraph—the distilled conclusion of decades of research, correspondence, and published work:

Iran's constitution includes eight clauses calling for hostility against the United States. America cannot normalize relations with a regime that threatens us on paper while its terrorist cells, operating with the Supreme Leader's consent, have looted Iran and deposited billions of stolen dollars in the West. Stand strong: impose smart sanctions and seize the assets of regime elites, terrorist networks, and looters until those eight clauses are removed.
