

Three years ago, our organization, Cyrus Force, launched a campaign for regime change in Iran by addressing the root cause of the Islamic Republic, rather than merely confronting its symptoms.

For decades, Western policy toward Iran has focused on reacting to the regime's actions without fully recognizing the true source of the problem: the Constitution of the Islamic Republic.

Ayatollah Khomeini imposed this constitution through deception, intimidation, and even the elimination of those who opposed Article 5, the doctrine of "Velayat-e Faqih," or the absolute rule of the Supreme Jurist.

At Cyrus Force, we prepared a letter to United States Senators identifying specific articles within Iran's constitution that have been the root cause of the crises the world has witnessed over the past 47 years.

In that letter, we made clear that the first concern in our minds was the security and survival of Israel.

My colleagues — Paul Vallely, Joe Kaufman, and Sheri Ruz — joined me in signing this letter, and together we distributed it to Senators through our own contacts and through friends across many states.

Two years ago, I also wrote a short book titled "The Road Map," presenting the same constitutional solution for Iran.

Even during the current conflict that began last June, we continued writing letters — sometimes daily — and posting them on the White House website.

We continued this effort until May 9th. Our final letter to President Donald Trump was titled: "Mr. Ayatollah, Tear Down This Constitution."

Last week, Cyrus Force decided to combine our books and our letters to the President into a single publication. I am pleased to say that this book is now available on Amazon.
