Strategic Opportunity for U.S. Leadership

The Soviet Union presents a unique opportunity to reshape American engagement across the region — from Eastern Europe to Central Asia, and most importantly, the Middle East. As President Reagan once said, Israel remains America's foremost ally and strategic asset. However, Armenia — a historic, Orthodox Christian nation — is an untapped treasure, a gateway to thousands of miles of influence, commerce, and security.

The strategic significance of **Project Armenia** cannot be overstated. Its success is vital to supporting the Cyrus Force Road Map, establishing a U.S.-backed base in Armenia is essential for the final stages of our Road Map that will lead to a constitutional change and regime transition in Iran. Securing Trade Corridors and US influence in Armenia enables control over both the modern Silk Road from China and the North-South Corridor from India, ensuring these routes serve U.S. and allied interests. Protecting Energy Assets – the world's largest untapped natural gas field in Chalous (Caspian Sea), discovered by the Soviet Union, is now being handed to Putin by Khamenei. Without Project Armenia, this critical resource will be lost to US rivals.

Creating a Regional Hub for Prosperity – The Zangezur corridor can host a cultural, commercial, and tourism hub — a "Caucasus Riviera" for Americans and Europeans. We envision a landmark center, inspired by the ancient Persian capital "Ewān-e Madain" (1500 years old, near Baghdad), reconstructed in gold as a tribute to Queen Shirin, the Armenian queen of Iran, symbolizing the historic bond between our nations. Recent developments highlight the urgency of action: Reports indicate that fighters from the extremist group Tahrir al-Sham have been transferred from Syria to Azerbaijan, prompting Putin himself to stage military maneuvers near Baku.

Today's BBC report (attached) reveals the fragile and unpredictable ties between Putin and Pashinyan, raising questions about who truly controls the region and who will prevail in any

escalation. If U.S. policymakers seize the opportunity to support **Project Armenia**, Washington can ensure that, regardless of Erdogan's ambitions, Putin's maneuvers, Tehran's influence, or Beijing's strategies, America will lead both strategically and financially.

The path is clear. We must not allow distractions or false narratives to derail it.
