

Dear Mr. President,

Before the current uprising in Iran, we saw no meaningful action from our favorite Republican Senators, even after we personally gave them our book “The Road Map.” That book contains two very simple and fundamental requests from your administration:

- 1- Read the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Iran and recognize that it is openly a manifesto of war against the United States.
- 2- Demand the removal of these terrorist clauses from their Constitution and impose smart sanctions on the oligarchy of Ayatollahs by confiscating their assets — the same assets that finance terrorist networks across the world.

These are not random incidents — they are the voice of a nation asking for a peaceful and lawful transition through a “Constitutional Assembly (Moasessan)” to rewrite Iran’s future. This is the real slogan, the real demand, and the real path for millions of Iranians inside Iran.

Yet this crucial message has been overshadowed in America by two wealthy spoilers who distort the Iranian movement: Reza Pahlavi and Maryam Rajavi.

Mr. President,

I beg you — please do not attack Iran militarily.

Instead, attack the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Iran with a five-minute speech.

If you make that five-minute speech, just sit back and watch the people of Iran do the rest. They are ready. They are waiting. They only need the United States to speak the truth.
