Subject: ***Critical U.S. Policy Priorities on Iran’s Constitutional Hostility***

Dear President Trump,

As Iranian-American Republican, we want to thank you for publicly supporting the Iranian uprising, and—more importantly—for rejecting the pressure of powerful lobbyists to endorse a deeply unpopular and compromised figure as an “alternative leader” to Iran’s current tyrants. Your instincts were right.

For years, through our book ***The Road Map*** and our letters and online publications, we have documented a core strategic fact that continues to be ignored by many in Washington: there are eight explicit clauses in the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Iran that mandate hostility toward the United States, terrorism against our interests, and undermining of our allies globally.

With such a constitution in place, there is no meaningful basis for negotiation on any issue with this regime. Your Iran policy recognized this reality more clearly than any administration before you.

Over the past twenty years, during every major Iranian uprising strong enough to draw international attention, one individual—Reza Pahlavi—using enormous inherited wealth and a powerful lobby, has successfully diluted legitimate opposition and redirected media narratives into personality politics rather than the real strategic threat: the Islamic Republic’s constitutional doctrine of terrorism.

Today’s uprising is viewed by millions of Iranians as the last historic opportunity to force constitutional change inside the country. If the constitution changes, any future government—regardless of who sits in the palace—will be forced to behave like a responsible state rather than a global terror enterprise.

Therefore, we respectfully repeat the two fundamental U.S. policy demands we will continue to advocate until they are addressed:

1. The United States should officially demand the removal of all terrorist and anti-American clauses from the Islamic Republic's constitution.

2. The United States should impose targeted "smart sanctions" on the oligarchs, thieves, and regime elite who have looted the country and built dormant terrorist networks around the world.

These two steps do not require war, do not require choosing a new monarch, and do not require interference in Iran's domestic politics. They simply defend American interests and align with the will of the Iranian people.
