

A Historic Opportunity at the Time of Ceasefire

Dear Mr. President,

A moment of ceasefire will eventually arrive. When it does, it will present a historic opportunity for leadership at the highest level.

Throughout your public life, you have demonstrated a willingness to challenge assumptions that others were unwilling to question. That independence of thought is precisely what this moment requires.

At that critical time, the two fundamental demands advanced by Cyrus Force offer a forward-looking alternative — one that safeguards American strength and resources while protecting the lives of our brave service members, as well as innocent civilians in Iran and Israel

But even before that moment arrives, a deeper question deserves national attention.

For more than four decades, the United States has confronted the Islamic Republic of Iran without fully examining the constitutional foundation that guides its conduct. The Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Iran is not merely a domestic governing document; it defines the regime's ideological commitments and its posture toward the outside world.

It would serve the American people well for Congress to carefully review that document and openly debate what kind of long-term relationship, if any, is possible under such a constitutional framework.

Rather than limiting national discussion to the War Powers debate alone, this is an opportunity to elevate the conversation. A thorough congressional review would place the issue where it belongs — within the constitutional and legislative responsibilities of the United States government.

Such a step would not escalate conflict. On the contrary, it would clarify the legal and strategic reality facing America and allow future policy to rest on informed judgment rather than assumption.

History often turns not only on force, but on clarity — and clarity requires courage.
