

Subject: *Iran – A Historic Opportunity for Peaceful Leadership Transition*
Constitutional Change and Smart Sanctions

March 6, 2026

Dear Mr. President,

Yesterday I wrote: “A moment of ceasefire will eventually arrive.”

Today I write about what may follow that moment.

You recently indicated that the United States may have a role in shaping Iran’s future leadership. Such a moment may soon arrive, and it presents a historic opportunity to guide events toward a peaceful outcome.

If a Constitutional Assembly is formed in Iran and a parliamentary constitution is established, the future government, parliament, and national leadership of Iran will naturally become allies of the United States. This reality was recognized by many respected American scholars decades ago, whose vision has been buried under forty-seven years of deceptive rhetoric from the Ayatollahs’ regime.

When the dust settles, and when our two fundamental demands are applied — constitutional change in Iran and smart sanctions against the corrupt regime elite — the path forward will fall into place naturally.

For this historic shift, we do not need a new bill. What we need is for Congress to simply read the current Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Iran and recognize that it is not a democratic constitution, but a document that institutionalizes hostility toward the United States and its allies.

Mr. President, Your leadership has already shown the courage to challenge long-standing assumptions in foreign policy. At this critical moment, applying these two fundamental steps can open the door to a peaceful transition in Iran.

History rarely offers a moment when one leader can help a great nation reclaim its freedom without war. This may be such a moment.

We are approaching the final stage of the Road Map to rescue the Iranian people and close the chapter of the Ayatollahs’ regime — by implementing the two fundamental demands we have consistently presented.
