Thank you for taking the time to share your views regarding America's approach toward Iran.

As President, I am proudly advancing a foreign policy of peace through strength that puts America first—because when our country is strong, the world is stable, and Americans are more secure, prosperous, and free.

As President of the United States, I will continue leading with strength and resolve by pursuing peaceful resolutions that put our country first, protecting our citizens, and promoting stability and prosperity both at home and abroad. We hope to never have to use our military, but when we do, we will win.
