

Subject: Stop the War — Win Iran Without Firing a Shot

Mr. President,

You have something no other American leader has: genuine goodwill among millions of Iranians. They do not chant against you. They see you as a strong leader who is not afraid to challenge the establishment.

That political capital is more powerful than missiles.

Military escalation strengthens the Ayatollahs. External attack allows them to silence opposition, tighten control, and extend their survival. History shows this clearly.

But there is another path — one that weakens the regime without strengthening it.

Attack the regime from the Constitutional Front.

Expose the anti-American and anti-democratic foundations of their constitution. Support the Iranian people's right to demand structural reform. Use the most effective weapon already in your arsenal: smart, targeted sanctions aimed at regime elites — not the population.

You have said repeatedly that America must focus on winning economically and competing with China. A prolonged Middle East war drains American resources and risks pushing Iran permanently into China's orbit.

Instead, imagine the alternative:

A post-theocratic Iran rebuilding its infrastructure, energy sector, transportation system, telecommunications, and industry — a reconstruction opportunity worth trillions of dollars in partnership with American companies.

If America leads that reconstruction, America wins.

If war continues, China will position itself to win.

Mr. President, you can stop the war and still win.

You can weaken the regime without strengthening it.

You can compete with China without expanding conflict.

History will remember the leader who avoided another endless war and instead opened the door to a free and economically rebuilt Iran.
